## SEPTIC PERMIT APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Check with Land Development office (706) 253-8850 to determine zoning density for the property. This may affect the total acreage required for building.

- 1. <u>Original</u> Level III Soil Report with the <u>colored stamp</u> and signature. (No emailed copies or photocopies). In subdivisions developed since 2000, copies may be on file.
- 2. A RECORDED Plat of the property.
- 3. House and floor plan for the specific house to be built (include porches, decks, garages, etc.)
  - Bringing your own 8½" x 11" copies will save time. (No large plans please).
  - · Sign each page of the plans
- 4. The proposed house footprint (with porches, decks, garages, and driveway) must be staked out on lot and property lines must be clearly marked or flagged.
- 5. A completed and signed Septic Permit Application.
- 6. Fees are based on square footage of house or mobile home and are as follows:

\$ 200 (up to 1,000 square feet)

\$ 250 (1,001 - 2,000 square feet)

\$ 350 (2,001 - 3,000 square feet)

\$ 400 (3,001 - 4,000 square feet)

\$ 500 (4,001 - 5,000 square feet)

\$ 600 (5,001 or more square feet)

\*\*\*There will be a \$100.00 extra trip charge if the inspector\*\*

Cannot find property by directions given, cannot gain access to property due to no gate code or locked

gate/chain or finds proposed house site not staked

\*\*Payment is due before permit will be released\*\*

Payment by cash, card or check (payable to the Pickens County Environmental Health Department)

On lots with limited space for a septic system (determined by the Environmental Health Specialist) a scaled site plan may be required.

Incomplete applications will not be taken and held for further information or until site is staked.

Make certain application is complete and site is ready to avoid a second trip to our office.
